



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ORDER

In the Government order read as 1st paper above Government have sanctioned a ratio of 1 : 4 between the Senior Medical Officer and Medical Officer in the Department of Indian Systems of Medicine and 75 posts of Medical Officers have been upgraded to that of Senior Medical Officer in general cadre. In the Specialist cadre there are 32 posts of Medical Officers as indicated below:-

These posts were not taken into account while upgrading the 75 posts of Senior Medical Officers. The Director, Indian Systems of Medicine has now requested to extend the 1 : 4 ratio to the specialist cadre also and to upgrade 5 posts of Medical Officer (Specialist) to that of Senior Medical Officer (Specialist).

2. Government have examined the matter and are pleased to sanction the 1 : 4 ratio between the Senior Medical Officer (Specialist) and Medical Officer (Specialist). Accordingly 5 posts of Medical Officer (Specialist) will be upgraded to that of Senior Medical Officer (Specialist).
