The Government Ayurveda Dispensaries at Thrithalloor (Trichur District), Kothala (Kottayam District) and Thirurangadi (Malappuram District) were started in 3/86. The institutions are functioning with the staff deputed from other near by institutions. One surplus post of Medical Officer in Malappuram District has since been re-deployed to the Dispensary at Thirurangadi as per the G.O. read as 2nd paper above. The Director of Indian Systems of Medicine has reported that the Dispensaries cannot function with the staff deputed from other institutions any further. He has therefore sent up proposals for the creation of the minimum essential posts for the proper functioning of these institutions:
