In the circumstances Govt: are pleased to order that the Jilla Panchayat President who is the Chairman of Hospital Development Committee shall constitute Hospital Devpt. Committees in Dist: Hospitals. Also, the Lay Secretary of Dist: Hospitals shall be the Treasurer of Hospital Development Committees.



O R D E R

The plan write up of 1999-2000 envisages the starting of 100 new Ayurveda dispensaries in the State during the current financial year. An amount of Rs.100 lakhs is also provided in the annual budget(1999-2000) for this purpose under the head of account 2210-04-101-99. Accordingly, in the letter read above, the Director of Indian System of Medicines requested Government to accord sanction for the starting of one hundred new Ayurveda dispensaries in the State during 1999-2000 and also for the creation of one post each of Medical Officer, Pharmacist, Attender and Part-time sweeper for each dispensary.

2) Government examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to accord sanction for the starting of 100 new Ayurveda dispensaries in the State in a phased manner. As a first phase, sanction is accorded for the starting of fifty new Ayurveda dispensaries in the State during the financial year 1999-2000. 


