O R D E R :

The Physicians in the Ayurveda College Hospitals are not now taking any classes for the students. They are also not qualified to become Lecturers. It is considered unnecessary to have a large number of Physicians in the College Hospitals as a separate category. In the Medical College Hospitals, the Tutors, Asst. Professors, Associate Professors etc. take classes for the students as well as attend to the patients in the hospitals. The same arrangement has to be introduced in the Government Ayurveda Colleges also.

2. The question of re-designating the posts of Physicians Rs. 225-450 in the Ayurveda College Hospitals as Tutors (Rs. 225-450) was discussed by the Minister for Health and Co-operation with the the Director of Indigenous Medicine and the Principals of the two colleges. It was decided that the Physicians should be re-designated as Tutors. They should attend to the treatment of patients and also take classes for the students. Accordingly the following orders are issued:-

(i) The posts of Physicians under the Ayurveda Colleges will re-designated as Tutors with the same scale of pay viz. Rs. 225-450.

(ii) The Tutors will take classes in the Ayurveda Colleges and will also treat the patients in the Collegiate Hospitals.

(iii) In future no direct recruitment to the post of Lecturers will be made but qualified Tutors/Demonstrators will be promoted as Lecturers.

(iv) Hereafter only degree holders will be appointed as Tutors as prescribed by the University.

(v) In the case of Physicians now working under the Ayurveda Colleges they will be allowed to continue as Tutors even after their designation is changed as Tutor. They will be given exemption from Degree Qualification to hold the post in consultation with the University and the Public Service Commission. But they will not be eligible for promotion as Lecturers till they get themselves qualified undergoing the Degree Course. The designation of the specialist Physicians will be Tutor (Marma), Tutor (Netra), Tutor (Visha) etc.

(vi) The post of Assistant Superintendent-cum.Chief Physicians Rs. 325-725 in the Ayurveda College Hospital, Trivandrum will be re-designated as Chief Physician. There are three Senior Physicians one Senior Specialist Physician on Rs. 310-600 in the Ayurveda College Hospital., Trivandrum and one Chief Physicians (Rs.325-725) and one Senior Physician(Rs. 310-600) in the Ayurveda College Hospital, Tripunithur. All the posts of Chief Physicians and Senior Physicians in the College Hospitals will be shifted to the respective College Pharmacies for the efficient working of the Pharmacies and they will continue without any change of designation except that of Assistant Superintendent-cum-Chief Physician which will be re-designated as Chief Physician as ordered above. An equal number of posts of Physicians (Rs. 225-450) will be shifted from the Pharmacies to the Respective College Hospitals, and their designation will be changed as Tutors.

(vii) The Tutors who do not possess Degree Qualification and who have no chance for promotion as Lecturer will be promoted as Senior Physician and Chief Physician, in the two College Pharmacies when their turn comes, so as to protect their existing chances of promotion.

3. This order will come into force with effect from 1-4-1973.

4. The Director of Indigenous Medicine and the Principals of Ayurveda Colleges will take immediate steps to implement the orders.

O R D E R.

In the G.O. read above, sanction was accorded authorising the Director of Indigenous Medicine to incur expenditure to the tune of Rs.ten lakhs only for the Schemes for opening of Ayurveda and Homoeo dispensaries and for increasing bed-strength in existing hospitals. Meanwhile the Director had sent up proposals for opening 11 Ayurveda dispensaries and 11 Homoeo dispensaries during 1972-73.

The Government have examined the proposal. Sanction is hereby accorded for opening eleven Ayurveda dispensaries (one in each District) and eleven Homoeo dispensaries (one in each Dist) during 1972-73.



ORDER.

In the G.O. read as 2nd paper above, general administrative sanction was accorded inter-alia for the implementation of the schemes for opening of 250 Rural dispensaries in the State. The working group constituted as per G.O. read as 1st paper above for programmes relating to Health discussed the various aspects of the scheme and recommended that the list of Panchayats where the dispensaries are to be set up should be finalised by 15th June 1973 and that the last doctor should be in position by the 15th Aug.73. They have also recommended that necessary sanction for the implementation of the Scheme should be issued immediately pending ~~the~~ selection of Panchayats.

2. In the circumstances, sanction is accorded for opening of 250 Rural dispensaries (100 Allopathic, 100 Ayurveda & 50 Homoeo) during the current financial year in Panchayats where there are no Govt. medical institutions.

3. The location of the dispensaries will be decided shortly and separate orders will be issued.

4. The setting up of the dispensaries will be subject to the following conditions.

(i) The new dispensaries will be set up in Panchayats where there are no Govt. medical institutions and as far as possible in a central area of the Panchayat and at least 3 to 4 Km. away from the nearest Govt. medical institution.

(ii) The medical officer in charge of the dispensary should reside close to the dispensary.

(iii) The building selected should be suitable for running the dispensary.

(iv) The Panchayats should provide Residential Quarters to the Medical Officers/Physicians subject to payment of reasonable rent by the Medical Officer/Physicians concerned.

(v) In the case of allopathic dispensaries the Panchayat should surrender at least one acre of suitable land and a type design building approved by the Dist. Medical Officer concerned within six months. In the case of Ayurveda and Homoeo dispensaries, the Panchayat should surrender at least 25 cents of land and a type design building approved by the D.I.M.O./The Director of Homoeopathy as the case may be within six months. Pending construction and surrender of a type design building, the Panchayat should provide a suitable building, ~~for~~ for opening the dispensary free of rent to Govt., they should also carry out necessary maintenance to the building as and when found necessary. An undertaking to this effect will be obtained from the Panchayats by the D.M.O./D.I.M.O./the Director of Homoeo as the case may be. If the above conditions are not satisfied the sanction accorded for opening of dispensaries is liable to be withdrawn.

4) The immediate requirements of medicines, equipments and furniture will be provided by the D.M.O/Director of Homoeopathy/D.I.M.O. as the case may be from the existing stock. Where the existing stock of furniture is not adequate, the Panchayats concerned should provide them as a temporary measure till Govt. are in a position to supply the required furniture.

5) The following temporary posts are sanctioned for each dispensary till 28-2-74. The staff will be posted only at the time of opening of each dispensary.




