

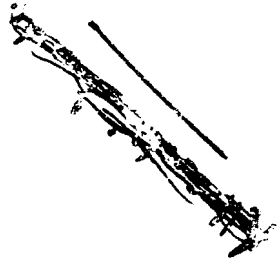

Order

1. Sanction is accorded for increasing the bed strength of the 4 existing Ayurveda Hospitals from 6 to 10 and also to upgrade one Ayurveda Dispensary into a 10 bedded hospital. The institutions thus upgraded into 10 bedded Ayurveda Hospitals are:-

- (1) Government Ayurveda Hospital, Kottoor (Trivandrum Dist)
- (2) Government Ayurveda Hospital, Meenadam (Kottayam Dist)
- (3) Government Ayurveda Hospital, Annamanada (Trichur District)
- (4) Government Ayurveda Hospital, Velimukku (Malappuram Dist.)
- (5) Government Ayurveda Dispensary, Thozhanur (Malappuram Dist)

2. Sanction is also accorded for the creation/redesignation/abolition of the following posts.

- (1) Nurses on Rs. 230--385 : - 6 - (Six)
One each for Kottoor, Meenadam, Annamanada, Velimukku and two for Thozhanur.
- (2) Pharmacist on Rs. 230-385: - 1 - (One) for Annamanada
- (3) One post of Attender now available in the Government Ayurveda Dispensary, Thozhanur will be redesignated as Hospital Attendant on Rs. 200--285.
- (4) Pharmacy Attender on Rs. 200--285 : -5- (Five)
One each for Kottoor, Meenadam, Annamanada, Velimukku and Thozhanur.
- (5) Cook on Rs. 196--265 : -1- (one) for Thozhanur
- (6) Scavenger cum Sweeper on Rs. 196--265 : -2- (Two)
One each for Meenadam and Thozhanur.
- (7) Three posts of Scavenger now available in the Government Ayurveda Hospitals at Kottoor, Annamanada and Velimukku will be redesignated as Scavenger-cum-Sweeper.

(8) Five posts of Part Time Sweeper available in the Government Ayurveda Hospital at Kottoor, Meenadam, Annamanada and Velimukku and at Government Ayurveda Dispensary, Thozhannur will be abolished.

3. The posts newly created will be temporary and will continue till the end of February 1979 in the first instance. The additional posts sanctioned for the Government Ayurveda Hospital, Kottoor and Velimukku will be filled up only after completion of the construction of the buildings for the hospitals.

4. The expenditure on this account will be met from the provision under "280 B (a) 2 (vii) increasing bed strength in existing Ayurveda Hospitals" in the current year's budget.


