- (i) The Panchayat will obtain the approval of the  
Director, Indian Systems of Medicine for the  
site plan and design of the building proposed  
to be constructed.
- (ii) The building should have necessary facilities  
such as water, electricity, latrine, etc.
- (iii) The Panchayat will obtain and forward to the  
Director, Indian Systems of Medicine the structural  
stability certificate of the building from the  
P.W.D. after the building is constructed.
- (iv) The Panchayat will not seek any financial assistance  
from Government for the construction of the building.
- (v) The question of upgrading the Dispensary will be  
considered only later subject to availability of  
funds after the building is handed over to the  
Department of Indian Systems of Medicine.

Wadakkanchery Panchayat - Trasfer of land in Sy.No.1282/8, 619/5,6,7 of Wadakkanchery Village to the Ayurvedic Dispensary sanctioned - Revised orders issued.

O R D E R

In the G.O. read as first paper above sanction was accorded to the Wadakkanchery Panchayat to transfer one acre and ~~33 3/4~~ 33 3/4 cents of land in Sy. No.619/5,6,7 and 1282/8 of Wadakkanchery Village to the Department of Indian Systems of Medicine for the construction of a 25 bedded hospital. Subsequently the Director of Indian System of Medicine in his letter read as second paper informed government that the Wadakkanchery Panchayat informed him that they want to utilize 4 3/4 cents of land out of the 1 acre and 33 3/4 cent, for the purpose of a public road and hence transfer the remaining one acre and 29 cents only to the Department of Indian System of Medicine. The Director of Indian System of Medicine has no objection to it. The Secretary, Board of Revenue has also requested Government to modify is earlier orders and to ratify the action of the District Collector Trichur in having transferred one acre and 29 cents only to the Director of Indian System of Medicine.

In view of the facts above revised sanction is accorded to transfer one acre and 29 cents of land to the Director of Indian System of Medicine leaving 4 3/4 cents of land (1 1/2 cents in Sy.No.619/7 and 3/4 cents in sy.No.1282/82) for the proposed pathway. The action of the District Collector Trichur in having transferred one acre and 29 cents to Director of Indian System of Medicine is also ratified.


