ORDER

Sanction is accorded to the Director, Indian Systems of Medicine, Trivandrum to accept the 25 cents of land offered by the local committee, Valappad Panchayat constituted for the establishment of an Ayurveda Hospital in Memory of Vashoo Sreenivasan Vaidyar without any financial commitment on the part of the Government and subject to the following terms and conditions. :

- (i) The hospital will be opened after the completion of the building and subject to availability of funds only.
- (ii) The Committee will obtain the approval of the Director, Indian Systems of Medicine for the site plan and design of the building proposed to be constructed.
- (iii) The building should have necessary facilities like water, electricity, latrines, etc.
- (iv) The Committee will obtain and forward to the Director, Indian Systems of Medicine the structural stability certificate of the building from the P.F.D. after the completion of the building.
- (v) The Committee will not seek any financial assistance from Government for the construction of the building.

ORDER

Government are pleased to order that the Medical Officers and other hospital employees of the Department of Indian Systems of Medicine will be eligible for compensation leave and weekly off as follows:-

1. Weekly off:-

For an employee who is on duty for 6 days continuously in a week the 7th day will be off for him. The casual leave and compensation leave availed of by him during those six days will also be treated as duty for granting weekly off. But an employee, who avails of casual leave, compensation leave and weekly off at a stretch for a week and more will not be eligible for weekly off.

2. Compensation leave:

All the hospital employees will be eligible for compensation leave subject to a maximum of 22 days in a year.


