

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ORDER

In the circumstances reported by the Director of Indian Systems of Medicine the letter read above, Government order that twenty beds from the Government Ayurveda Hospital, Kottakkal be shifted to the Government Ayurveda Hospital, Kozhikode and the bedstrength of the Government Ayurveda Hospital, Kozhikode be fixed as thirty. Provision is also accorded for the shifting of the following posts from the Government Ayurveda Hospital, Kottakkal to the Government Ayurveda Hospital, Kozhikode permanent- including the post of Chief Medical Officer, already shifted for a period of one year as per the G.O. read above:-

ORDER

As per the G.O. read above, sanction was accorded to the Director of Indian Systems of Medicine to accept the 25 cents of land offered by the local committee, Valappad Panchayat for establishing an Ayurveda Hospital in memory of Vazheer, Sreenivasan Vaidyar subject to the condition that the committee would construct to type-design building and hand it over to the Department with the structural stability certificate of the Public Works Department. The Director of Indian Systems of Medicine has reported in his letter read above that the land has been accepted and the local committee has constructed a type design building for the dispensary. He has therefore recommended to sanction an Ayurveda Dispensary in Valappad Panchayat.

2.Sri. Sidharthan Kattungal M.L.A. has also stated that the building has been constructed and fitness certificate of the Public Works Department has been obtained. He has requested to issue sanction to open the Dispensary in Memory of Vazheer Sreenivasan Vaidyar.

3. Under the above circumstances, sanction is accorded for opening an Ayurveda Dispensary in Valappad Panchayat in memory of Vazheer Sreenivasan Vaidyar. The Dispensary will be started after the building is taken over by the Department from the local committee. The staff for the Dispensary will be found from the surplus staff available in the Department for re-deployment. The Director of Indian Systems of Medicine will forward specific proposals to Government in this respect.
