



O R D E R

The 1992-93 plan contemplates upgradation of one Ayurveda Dispensary into a 20 bedded Hospital under the "Minimum Needs Programme". The Director of Indian Systems of Medicine forwarded proposals to upgrade the Ayurveda Dispensaries at Palakkuzha (Ernakulam District) and Venganoor (Thiruvananthapuram District) into 20 bedded hospitals and pointed out that there is enough budget provision for this.

The Working Group in its meeting held on 29-7-1992 recommended to upgrade one dispensary into a 20 bedded hospital subject to availability of budget provision. Accordingly the Director of Indian Systems of Medicine proposed to upgrade the Ayurveda Dispensary at Palakkuzha creating certain additional posts.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the Government Ayurveda Dispensary, Palakkuzha be upgraded into a 20 bedded hospital with existing staff and the following posts be filled by redeployment.
