There are two 100 bedded hospitals in the Department of Indian Systems of Medicine, at Kannur and Kozhikkode. When the bed strength of these hospitals was increased from 50 to 100 the post of Chief Medical Officer was upgraded as Superintendent. Three posts of Medical Officer/ Senior Medical Officer were also sanctioned, which are inter-transferable. The Director Indian Systems of Medicine has reported that when the Superintendent in a 100 bedded hospital is promoted as District Medical Officer that post could remain vacant, affecting the day-to-day administration of the hospital since the Superintendent is the drawing and disbursing officer. In order to tide over this difficulty he has proposed to upgrade the Senior Medical Officer/Medical Officer in the 100 bedded hospitals to that of Chief Medical Officer.

2. Government have examined the proposal in detail. They are pleased to accord sanction for the upgradation of the post of ~~Senior~~ Medical Officer on Rs.2060-3200/ Senior Medical Officer on Rs.2375-3500 to that of Chief Medical Officer on Rs.2500-4000 in the two 100 bedded Ayurvedic hospitals at Kannur and Kozhikkode, in relaxation of economy orders.
