

ORDER:

In para 4 of the G.O. cited, Government accepted the donation of land and building made by Sri. K. Balarama Panicker for starting an Ayurveda Dispensary either by opening a new dispensary there or by shifting one from some adjacent area whichever is expedient. The acceptance of this offer is subject to the condition that the new Ayurveda dispensary will be named after the donor's father.

The Director of Indigenous Medicine in his letter cited has requested Government to accord administrative sanction for the opening of new Ayurveda dispensary in the site offered by Sri.K.Balarama Panicker and for naming the dispensary after the Donor's Father, suggesting to meet the expenditure involved from anticipated Savings under the Non-Plan provision; there being no Savings under the Plan provision for the current year. As the opening of new Ayurveda Dispensary which is a Plan Scheme from Non-Plan provision is inadmissible, the Director of Indigenous Medicine was requested to explore the possibility of shifting one of the existing Government Ayurveda Dispensaries which are now housed in rented buildings to the land and buildings donated by Sri. K. Balarama Panicker without at the same time causing the least inconvenience to the public. The Director of Indigenous Medicine has accordingly suggested that the Govt. Ayurveda Dispensary at Achencoil (Quilon District) now accommodated in rented building may be shifted and located at Kunnathur in the site and building donated by Sri. K. Balarama Panicker utilising the funds allotted for Achencoil dispensary. It is also reported by the Director of Indigenous Medicine that the attendance in this dispensary is poor. He has also suggested that First Grade Grant-in-aid Vaidyasala may be sanctioned in the place of the regular dispensary proposed to be shifted from Achencoil.

Government have examined the proposal and are pleased to order that the Government Ayurveda Dispensary at Achencoil shall be shifted to Kunnathur in the site and building donated by Sri. K. Balarama Panicker utilising the funds allotted for the Achencoil dispensary. The Government Ayurveda dispensary so shifted shall be named after the Donor's father.

Regarding his proposal to start a first grade Grant-in-aid Vaidyasala at Achencoil, the Director of Indigenous Medicine is requested to submit separate proposals pointing out funds for the purpose.

In the G.O. 1st cited, Government, have accorded administrative sanction for the construction of a building for the Ayurveda Hospital, Kodakara at an estimated cost of Rs. 55,000/-. The Director of Indigenous Medicine in his letter 2nd cited has reported that the Executive Engineer (Buildings & Roads), Trichur has forwarded a revised estimate amounting to Rs. 87,600/- for the construction of the above building and so he requests Government to issue revised orders amounting to Rs. 87,600/- for the above construction work.

At the conference held in the room of the Health Minister on 18-7-1967, it has also been agreed that this dispensary which is decided to be located at Trivandrum will be organised by the Kerala Siddha Vaidya Federation.

Having regard to the recommendations of the Director of Indigenou's Medicine on the Federation's proposals for starting the Dispensary, the following orders are issued.

The Dispensary will be conducted as a Govt. institution in the Department of Indigenou's Medicine.

The Federation will take a building on a rent not exceeding Rs.50/- p.m. subject to the rent certificate issued by the Executive Engineer of the Public Works Department for a period of three years and subject to the consent obtained from the owner of the building.

Purchase of medicines to the Siddha Dispensary will be made after calling for open tenders.

A nominee of the Kerala Siddha Vaidya Federation with 'A' Class Registration will be appointed as Honorary Physician on an honorarium of Rs.200/- p.m. for a period of one year on contract basis for the present, pending regular appointment to the post of Physician. Other staff referred to above will be appointed by the department either on the advice of Public Service Commission or through the Employment Exchange as the case may be, or by transfer from other institutions.

The allotment for an year for the dispensary is Rs.0.125 lakh. For the current year a proportionate amount of Rs.5,000/- is sanctioned for the dispensary in view of the fact that the initial expenses for opening the dispensary towards purchase of furniture, etc. have to be met this year itself. If additional amount is required, it will be considered on the recommendation of the Director of Indigenou's Medicine.

Furniture and other equipments will be arranged to be purchased by the Dist. Indigenous Medical Officer, Trivandrum, observing Stores Purchase Rules and limiting the expenditure to the provision sanctioned.

The Stationery articles, printed forms, Registers, etc. will be supplied by the Dist. Indigenous Medical Officer, Trivandrum.

For the proper running of the institution and advising and giving guidance, an Advisory Committee of the Federation consisting of 3 or 5 members will be constituted with the Director of Indigenous Medicine as the Chairman and the Hon. Vaidyan as the Secretary. The above orders will take effect immediately.






