ORDER:

The Physicians in the Ayurveda Cellege Hespitals are not now taking any classes for the students. They are also not qualified to become Lecturers. It is considered unnecessary to have a large number of Physicians in the Cellege Hespitals as a separate category. In the Medical Cellege Hespitals, the Tuters, Asst. Prefessors, Associate Professors etc. take classes for the students as well as attend to the patients in the hespitals. The same arrangement has to be introduced in the Severnment Ayurveda Celleges also.

- 2. The question of re-designating the posts of Physicians Rg. 225-450) in the Ayurveda Cellege Hospitals as Tutors (Rs. 225-450) was discussed by the Minister for Health and Co-operation with the the Director of Indigenous Medicine and the Frincipals of the two celleges. It was decided that he Physicians should be re-designated as Tutors. They should attend to the treatment of patients and also take classes for the students. Accordingly the following orders are issued:-
- (1) The posts of Physicians under the Ayurveda Celleges will redesignated asTutors with the same scale of pay viz. Rs. 225-450.
- (ii) The Tuters will take classes in the Ayurveda Celleges and will also treat the patients in the Callegiate Hespitals.
- (iii) In future no direct recruitment to the post of Lecturers will be made but qualified Tutors/Demonstrators will be premoted an Lecturers.
- (iv) Hereafter only degree helders will be appointed as Tuters as prescribed by the University.
- (v) In the case of Physicians now working under the Ayurveda Celleger they will be allowed to centinue as Tuters even after their designation is changed as Tuter. They will be given exemption from Degree Qualification to hold the post in consultation with the University and the Public Service Commission. But they will not be eligible for premetion as Lecturers till they get themselves qualified undergoing the Degree Commse. The designation of the specialist Physicians will be Tuter (Marma), Tuter (Netra), Tuter (Visha) etc.
- Rs. 325-725) in the Ayurveda Cellege Hespital, Trivandrum will be redesignated as Chief Physician. There are three Senier Physicians ene Senier Specialist Physician en Rs. 310-600 in the Ayurveda Cellege Hespital., Trivandrum and one Chief Physicians (Rs. 325-725) and one Senier Physician (Rs. 310-600) in the Ayurveda Cellege Hespital, Tripunithum All the posts of Chief Physicians and Senier Physicians in the Cellege Hespitals will be shifted to the respective Cellege Pharmacies for the efficient working of the Pharmates and they will continue without any change of designation except and of Assistant Superintendent-cum-Chief Physician which will be re-designated as Chief Physician as ordered above. An equal number of posts of Physicians (Rs. 225-450) will be shifted from the Pharmacies to the Respective College Hespitals, and their respinantian will be changed as Eutors.

- (vii) The Tutors who do not possess Degree Qualification and who have no chance for promotion as Lecturer will be promoted as Benier Physician and Chief Physician, in the two College Pharmacies when their turn cames, so as to protect their existing chances of promotion.
 - 3. This order will come into force with effect from 1-4-1973.
- 4. The Director of Indigenous Medicine and the Principals of Ayurveda . Colleges will take immediate steps to implement the orders.

- (ii) The medical officer in charge of the dispensary should reside close to the dispensary.

(iii) The building selected should be suitable for running

the dispensary.

- (iv) The Panchayats should provide Residential Quarters to the Medical Officers/Physicians subject to payment of reasonable rent by the Medical Officer/Physicians, concerned.
- (v) In the case of allopathic dispensaries the Panchayat should surrender at least one acre of suitable land and a type design building approved by the Dist Medical Officer concerned within six months. In the case of Ayurveda and Homoeo dispensa-ries, the Panchayat should surrender at least 25 cents of land and a type design building approved by the D.I.M.O/The Director of Homoeopathy as the case may be within six months. - Pending construction and surrender of a type design building, the Panchayat should provide a suitable building, kar for opening the dispensary free of rent to Govt., they should also carry out necessary maintenance to the building as and when found necessary. An undertaking to this effect will be obtained from the Panchayats by the D.M.O. D.I.M.O./the Director of Homoco as the case may be. If the above conditions are not satisfied the sanction accorded for opening of dispensaries is liable to be withdrawn.

- The immediate requirements of medicines, equipments and furniture will be provided by the D.M.O/Director of Homocopathy/D.I.M.O. as the case may be from the existing stock. Where the existing stock of furniture is not adequate, the Panchayats concerned should provide them as a temporary measure till Gott. are in a position to supply the required furniture.
