

O R D E R

The Director of Health Services has reported that for the last 3 years there has been considerable increase in the number of outpatients and inpatients in the hospitals especially in the Taluk Head-Quarters Hospitals. Speciality services have been introduced to the Taluk Head-Quarters hospitals in addition to the commissioning of Pay wards. Besides, many cases go over to the Taluk Head-quarters hospitals referred from the peripheral institutions for the issue of medical certificates, treatment and reimbursement of cost of medicines. Thus the volume of work in the Taluk Head-Quarters hospitals has increased many fold warranting rigid supervision over the administrative matters as well as the hospital services. Moreover Medical Officers in charge of the Taluk Head-quarters hospitals should be relieved part of his administrative duties so as to enable him to perform better supervision over hospital services.

Taking all these aspects into consideration the Pai Committee has made the recommendation of the strengthening of the existing hospital administration. The Director of Health Services has recommended that 46 posts of Lay Secretaries and Treasurers on Rs. 650-1150 may be created in 41 Taluk Head-quarters hospitals and 5 other Major hospitals where the bed strength is 100 and above.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are convinced of the necessity to relieve the Medical Officers in charge of these hospitals from administrative responsibilities with a view to enabling them to devote more time and attention for patients care. Gazetted Ministerial Officer with the powers of Lay Secretaries and Treasurers will alone be able to relieve part of the administrative responsibilities of the Medical Officers. Accordingly sanction is accorded for the creation of 46 posts of Lay Secretaries and Treasurers in the Pay Scale of Rs.650-1150 in the hospitals mentioned in the Annexure.

The posts will be temporary and will continue till 28.2.1981.

The expenditure will be met 280 A(b) 25 Plan Schemes and additional expenditure if any will be accommodated within the overall plan outlay under 280 Medical for the current year.




