According to the existing pattern, Pharmacists are provided in the dispensaries. The Director of Indian Systems of Medicine has therefore, suggested that the question of creation of 96 posts of Pharmacists on Rs. 330-515 may be taken up in accordance with a phased programme and that 20 posts of Pharmacists may be created during the current financial year.
